SEPTEMBER 20

Arrival into Nairobi

Hemingways Nairobi (1 night, September 8-9)

A member of the Small Luxury Hotels of the World, it is considered the best boutique hotel in Nairobi.

SEPTEMBER 21

Light aircraft flight to Il Moran Camp

Il Moran Camp (2 nights, September 21-23)

Part of the Governor's Camp collection, Il Moran is regarded as a premiere camp in the Maasai Mara and is located in a prime position for viewing the Great Migration.

SEPTEMBER 23

Game Drive to Naboisho Camp

Naboisho Camp (3 nights, September 23-26)

Set in a private reserve, this luxury Asilia camp offers spectacular game viewing.

SEPTEMBER 26

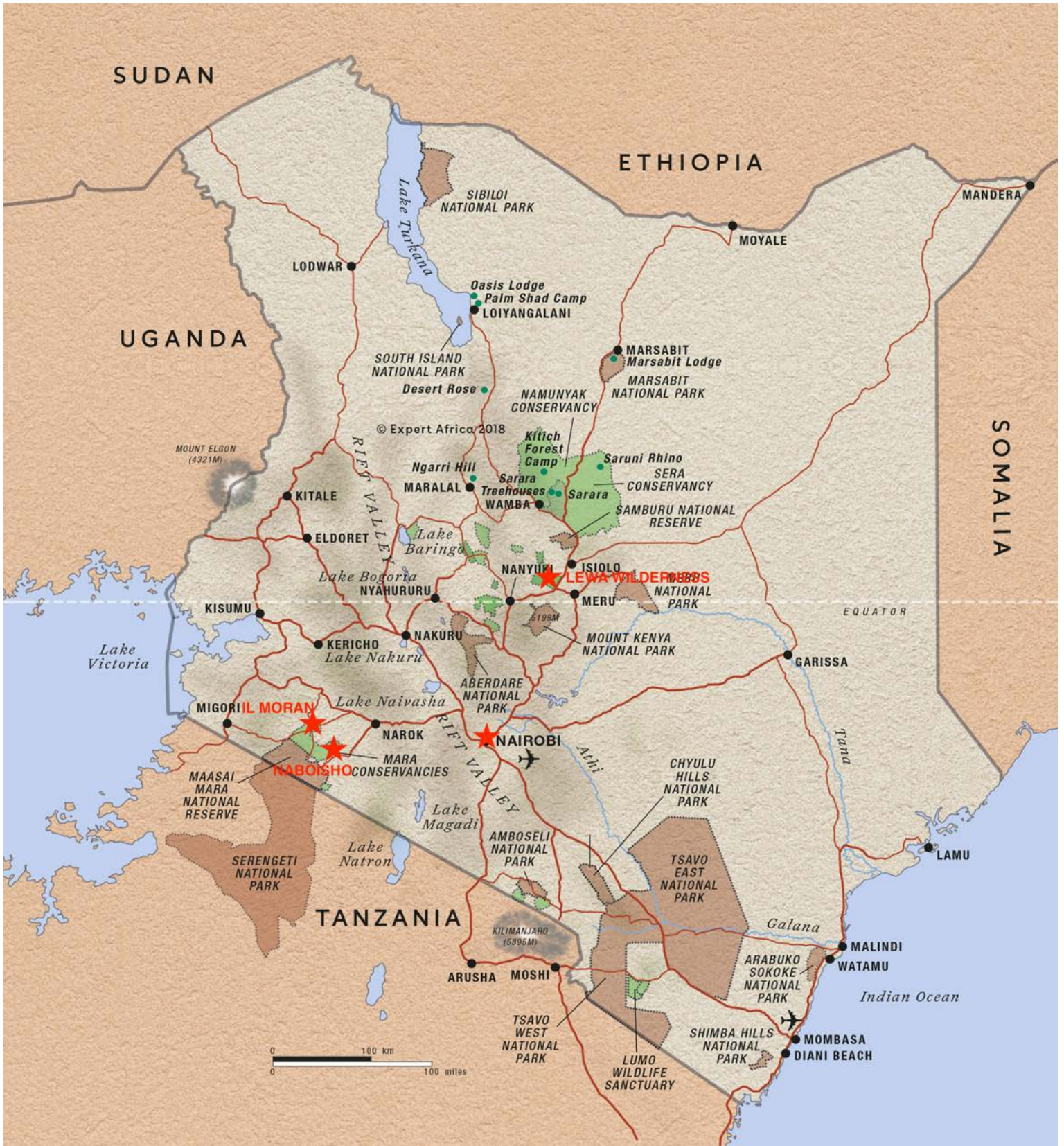
Light aircraft flight to Lewa Wilderness Lodge (3 nights, September 26-29)

Lewa sits at the base of Mount Kenya in the wild-life rich Lewa Conservancy.

SEPTEMBER 29

Light aircraft flight back to Wilson Airport and transfer to Nairobi international Airport for your departure flights.

SEPTEMBER 20, FRIDAY

Upon your arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) in Nairobi, you will be met immediately off your flight for special assistance through immigration and for your private road transfer to Hemingway's Nairobi.



IL MORAN CAMP

Part of the Governor's Camp Collection, Il Moran is widely regarded as the Premiere Camp in the Masai Mara, with a prime location for viewing the great migration. The tents line the banks of the Mara River, offering a bird's eye view of the snorting hippos below.

Each of the spacious tents have a private verandah and en-suite bathroom with bathtub and large shower.

SEPTEMBER 21, SATURDAY

This morning you will have a private road transfer to Wilson Airport for your light aircraft flight to

Il Moran Camp in heart of the legendary Maasai Mara National Reserve.



SEPTEMBER 22, SUNDAY

MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

As southern Kenya's premiere wildlife sanctuary, the Mara merges with Tanzania's Serengeti National Park to form an exceptional 6,000 square mile conservation area that is home to an incredible diversity of wildlife.

All of Africa's "big five" call the Maasai Mara home: lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and rhino. In addition, many antelope species flourish including Grant's gazelles, impalas, duikers, Coke's hartebeests, and roan antelopes. Hippopotamus and Nile crocodile inhabit the Mara and Talek rivers, which are the major suppliers of fresh water to the reserve.

Today go in search of the great migration as the wildebeest cross the Mara River in search of green grass in the Masai Mara National Reserve.

Be on the lookout for prides of lions, cheetah and leopard which are attracted by the herds of grazers.



THE GREAT MIGRATION

The endless plains of East Africa are the setting for the world's greatest wildlife spectacle – the great wildebeest migration. From August through October each year, over 1.4 million wildebeest and 200,000 zebra and gazelle migrate from Tanzania to the Mara of Kenya in search of rain ripened grass.

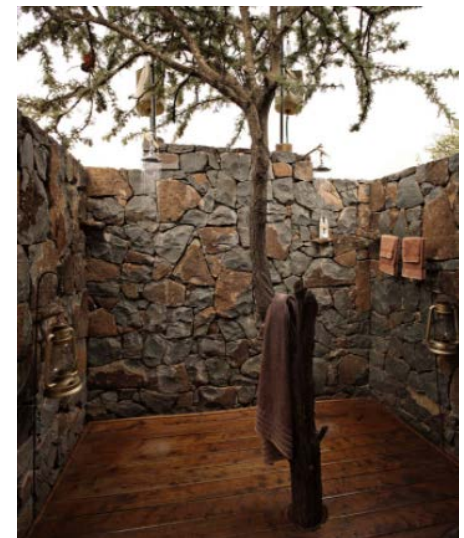

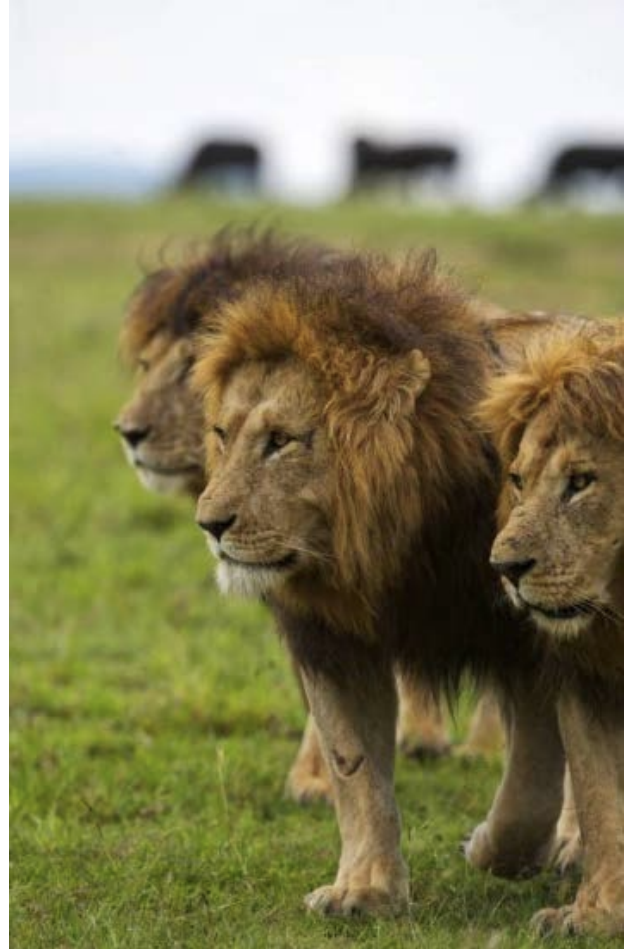
This morning you will game drive to Naboisho Camp, situated in the private Naboisho Conservancy on the northern border of the Maasai Mara National Reserve.

THE LEWA EXPERIENCE



The Lewa Wildlife Conservancy is a wildlife sanctuary located in northern Kenya and covers over 62,000 acres. It is home to some of the most endangered species in Africa, including the Black Rhino, White Rhino, Grevy's Zebra, Reticulated Giraffe, and the Fringe Eared Oryx.

Here you can also have an opportunity meet the rangers and have a glimpse of the flight that goes on behind the scenes to keep the wildlife safe.

In addition to safari game drives, guests can also choose to see the conservancy on horseback or by camel.



SEPTEMBER 29, SUNDAY

This morning you will transfer to the airstrip for your light aircraft flight back to Wilson Airport Nairobi.
